Course Information

Microsoft Certified IT Professional (**MCSA—Microsoft Certified Solutions Associate**) is a 320 clock hour course that is designed to introduce the student to the entry level knowledge of the infrastructure of the Microsoft Windows Server platform.

Course Focus and Emphasis

Participants will learn and be exposed to Microsoft Windows server environments and infrastructures including, but not limited to: domain names, ADD services, user and service accounts, group policy, network and file services, DAC, AD DS, AD RMS, AD FS, NLB, FC, FC with hyper-v, and VC DR.

Special emphasis is placed on the student successfully passing all certification examinations.
